Cemetery Plot Price Increase

The cost of operating and maintaining the Calvary Monument Bible Church Cemetery has significantly increased over the last several years. In order to properly continue the cemetery upkeep, we need to raise prices on cemetery plots and services. Effective Feb. 1, 2018, the cost of a cemetery plot will increase from \$300 to \$500. In addition, the cost of opening a plot will increase from \$500 to \$650. All plots sold between now and Feb. 1, 2018 will be sold at the current price of \$300.
