## ***"A New Type of Community"***

***Acts 4:32-5:11***

**Calvary Monument Bible Church**  
**February 1, 2026 Pastor Robert Reid**

What do people think when someone talks about the church community? In our culture the focus seems to be upon the style and operation of a group of people that are gathered together to worship God. In the New Testament the stress seemed to be more on the character of the people who met together and interacted with one another and their culture. Today we want to look at the qualities that stood out in the early church that had an impact on their culture.

### ***FIRST QUALITY***

***I. Unity*** Acts 4:32 *"Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul"*

- A. What Jesus desired for his followers – John 17:21-23
- B. What Paul challenged the church to do – Philippians 2:1-2
- C. What needed to be preserved – Ephesians 4:3-6
- D. What needed to be reflected – Galatians 3:28

### ***SECOND QUALITY***

***II. Charity*** Act 4:32b *"neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own"*

- A. Expressing love in action Cp. Acts 2:44-45
- B. Expressing and understanding of ownership Cp. Hebrews 13:16

### ***THIRD QUALITY***

***III. Generosity*** Acts 4:33-37

What did this generosity do?

- A. Displayed great power (33) – *"with great power"*
- B. Declared a great truth (33) – *"gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus"*
- C. Distributed great grace to others (33) – *"God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all" (NIV)*
- D. Demonstrated in extreme generosity (34-37)

### ***FOURTH QUALITY***

***IV. Integrity of life*** Acts 5:1-11

- A. Problem in the church (1-9)
- B. Purged the sin in the church (10-11)

### ***RESPOND***

1. Quote to ponder from the late Timothy Keller which he observed about the early church, "It was because the early church didn't fit in with its surrounding culture, but rather challenged it in love, that Christianity eventually had such an effect on it."
2. What qualities of the early church seem to be the weakest in the evangelical churches in the USA? Will you pray each week this month about one quality we looked at today and how it can be improved and manifested in our churches? Ask God to allow the Spirit to let that quality be seen in you and this local church.
3. Take one of the four verses we noted in the section on "unity" and write it down on a piece of paper or post it on your phone. Spend time this week memorizing and meditating upon it.





**To have a request put on the prayer chain,** call the church office (717-442-8161) during office hours (Mon.-Th., 8 AM-4 PM), or fill out the form on the "Contact" page on the church website.

**After hours EMERGENCY prayer chain:** Call the church emergency number (717-407-2106) and leave a voicemail. Non-emergency requests will be held until the office opens.

**To receive prayer chain requests,** please contact Amanda Vargas or mark the communication form.

### PRAYER CHAIN GUIDELINES

Please limit submissions to prayers for those within our church family or those with a close relationship with a friend or member of CMBC.

When requesting prayer for someone else, **you must have their permission** to place their request on our prayer chain.

All prayer requests will be reviewed by the office staff and edited as necessary.

Prayer chain emails should never be forwarded. Prayer requests are considered confidential.

### MEDICAL & FAMILY UPDATES

When you're in the hospital, anticipating surgery, or there has been a death in your family, we wish to provide care for you which will only be possible if we are aware of the event. Please inform the church staff of these types of events. If you are in the hospital, please inform the hospital of your affiliation with CMBC.

Please notify the church office if there has been a marriage or birth in your family that you would like to have announced in the Weekly. Contact Beth Cortez to have a photo placed on the family news bulletin board.

## GIVING

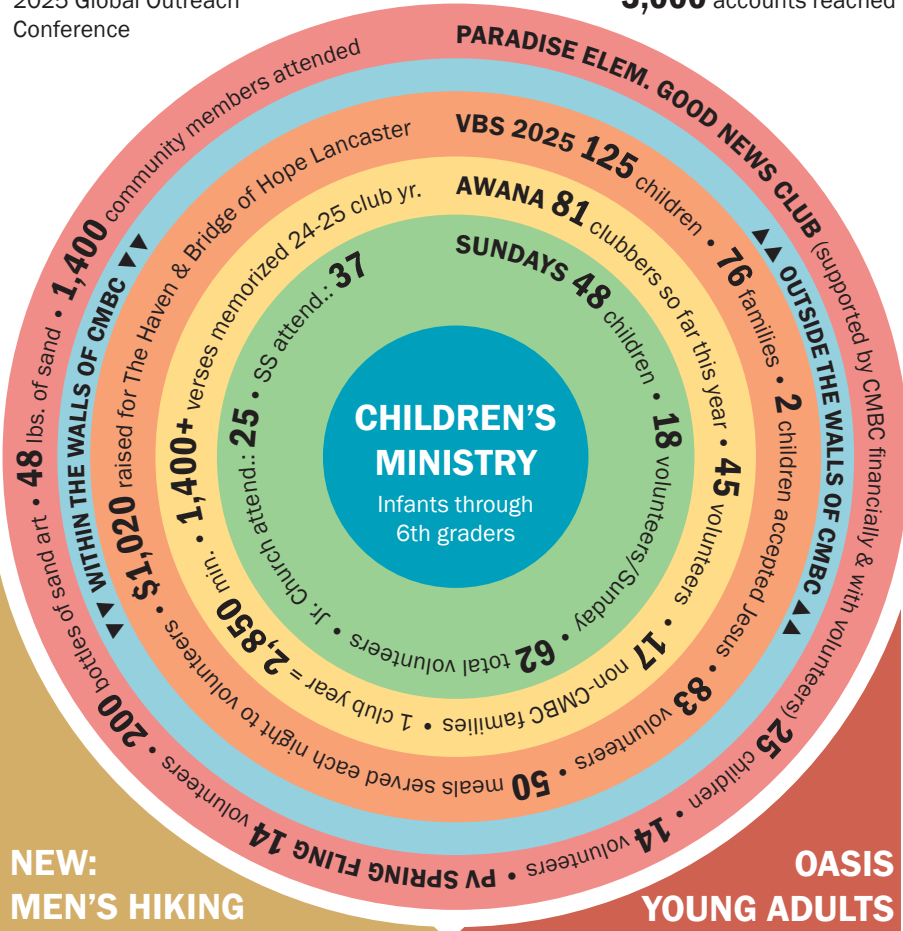
