

She spent years in advertising and public relations, learning how to read people, challenge the stories that hold them back, and communicate truth with both clarity and compassion. She's also a certified professional coach (ICF-ACC), blending biblical depth with practical tools for transformation.

Renata lives in Toronto with her husband of 22 years and their three children: Kaleb (21), Maja (18), and Lucy (16). Renata draws her strength from daily time with God, and she's committed to helping other women do the same.
