***Acts 20-21***

**Calvary Monument Bible Church**

There is a leadership crisis in our culture. It is especially obvious in the community of believers at a time when there is a crucial need for godly leaders.

Christians are needed to display qualities that will release the power of God into a world in decay. An impactful leader will be one guided by, controlled, and yielded to the Holy Spirit. Such a leader was the Apostle Paul who manifested four qualities of a Spirit-controlled leader in our study.

### ***FIRST QUALITY of a Spirit-controlled leader***

I. Uses his head wisely 20:1-6

A. To determine his ministry (1-2)

B. To direct his ministry (3)

C. To develop his ministry (4-6)

### ***SECOND QUALITY of a Spirit-controlled leader***

II. Opens his mouth boldly 20:7-12

A. When he spoke (7)

B. Who he spoke to (7)

C. What was their focus (7)

D. What was occurring (7-12)

### ***THIRD QUALITY of a Spirit-controlled leader***

III. Reveals his heart tenderly 20:13-38

A. His heart for service (18-21)

B. His heart for sacrifice (22-24)

C. His heart for saints (25-38)

### ***FOURTH QUALITY of a Spirit-controlled leader***

IV. Pursues his calling consistently 21:1-14

A. Counsel of people ignored (21:1-12)

B. Commitment maintained (13-14)
